INTERNATIONAL & DOMESTIC FLIGHT INSTRUCTIONS

Arrival in Nairobi, Kenya – Before November 2, 2025

To join the group on time:

- You must arrive in Nairobi, Kenya no later than November 1, 2025
- Plan your international flight to land on October 31st or early on November 1st
- Airport: Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO)

Why?

On November 2, the group will take a domestic flight from Wilson Airport (WIL) in Nairobi to the Maasai region. Missing this group flight means you'll miss the beginning of the safari experience. Group pickup at 8:30 AM from EKA Hotel, Nairobi, with private transfer to Wilson Airport.

• Flight Time: 10:30 AM Wilson → Mara | ETA 11:10 AM

Best advice: Book your flight to arrive **October 31** so you have one night to rest and recover from jet lag before the adventure begins. We can assist with booking your airport transfers and accommodation. Arriving a few days early means you can take advantage of some great activities the capital city of Nairobi has to offer.

Nairobi to Maasai Mara – November 2, 2025

- Group flight from Wilson Airport to Maasai Mara (included in itinerary)
- Be ready for an early morning pick-up and departure

Nairobi to Entebbe, Uganda – November 7, 2025

- The group will fly from **Wilson Airport** to **Entebbe International Airport (EBB)** in Uganda that same day. Choose a flight that departs Nairobi in the afternoon after 2pm. Example: Kenya Airways has a daily flight that departs NBO 2:15pm, arriving in Entebbe at 3:30pm.
- Generally a one-way flight will cost you \$200 to \$250USD
- This flight is not included, and you will need to book it yourself but we can assist in this process to including applying for the visas at an additional cost.



Recommended airlines:

- Kenya Airways (https://www.kenya-airways.com) or
- Uganda Airlines https://ugandairlines.com) offer direct flights.

Return Home – From Entebbe (Recommended) or Nairobi – November 13, 2025

- Recommended: Depart from Entebbe, Uganda on November 13th
- Optional: If you find a better airfare, you may return to **Kenya on the 13th** and fly out from Nairobi. In this case, a **multi-entry visa** is ideal (see visa section below)
- You may also be interested in exploring more of Uganda or even visit next door countries like Tanzania, Zanzibar.

VISA REQUIREMENTS & HOW TO APPLY

Kenya ETA (Electronic Travel Authorization)

Every traveler must apply online.

How to Apply:

- 1. Visit: https://www.etakenya.go.ke
- 2. Start the application portal
- 3. Upload passport copy, photo, and yellow fever certificate, travel details
- 4. Pay online (approx. \$32-\$50 USD) for single entry visa
- 5. If opting for a multi entry visa, you'd start that process with the Kenya portal
- 6. Approval takes 2–3 business days

Be sure to enter the same airport name where you will arrive: Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO)

Uganda Tourist Visa

Required for all travelers.

How to Apply:

- 1. Visit: https://visas.immigration.go.ug
- 2. Choose "Tourist Visa"
- 3. Upload passport, yellow fever certificate, passport photo, and travel itinerary
- 4. Pay online (approx. \$50 USD)
- 5. Approval within 2–4 business days

Port of entry: Entebbe International Airport (EBB)



East Africa Tourist Visa - Multi-Country Option

This visa allows entry to Kenya, Uganda, and Rwanda on a single visa, with multiple reentries between them.

When to choose this visa:

- You plan to **enter Kenya**, travel to **Uganda**, and then **return to Kenya** (e.g., for a return flight)
- Cost: Around \$100 USD
- Must be applied for through the **first country you enter** (in this case, **Kenya** via etakenya.go.ke)

Note: If you are flying into Kenya and departing from Uganda, the regular visas for each country are sufficient and may be easier to manage.

Summary of Best Booking & Visa Strategy

- Fly into Nairobi by November 1 at the latest
- Book flight from Nairobi (WIL) to Entebbe (EBB) for November 7
- Fly home from Entebbe on November 13
- Apply for:
 - o Kenya ETA
 - o Uganda Tourist Visa
 - o Or East Africa Tourist Visa if returning to Kenya after Uganda

YELLOW FEVER VACCINE – ENTRY REQUIREMENT FOR KENYA & UGANDA

Both Kenya and Uganda require proof of a Yellow Fever vaccination upon entry.

How and When to Get It:

- Get vaccinated at least 30 days before travel
- The vaccine is typically valid for **life**
- Obtain an official Yellow Fever Certificate (ICVP) from a certified clinic

Visit your nearest travel clinic, public health department, or private hospital. Some airports also offer this service.
